#### Intended Use

Skin marker is used for surgical marking on intact skin.

# Intended User/ Patient Target Groups

Intended to be used by Healthcare Professionals on patients requiring medical procedures.

#### Instructions for Use:

- Mark desired areas on skin with the skin marker according to facility protocol.
- · Allow the markings to dry on the skin for approximately 1 minute before rubbing or applying prep solution.
- · Apply prep solution as instructed by prep solution manufacturer.
- . The skin marker ink must be applied to intact, dry skin before applying prep solution. The skin marker ink will not adhere to prep solution or wet skin.

English

- Prepping the skin with isopropyl alcohol before marking may increase the adherence of the ink to the skin.
- When prep solution is applied over the skin marker ink, some of the marking will smear, but the skin marker ink will still be visible.
- · Rulers packaged with skin markers are not measuring devices and should be used as an indicator only, and not for accurate measurements.
- · Device is intended to write for up to 24 feet.
- Do not use product if product is damaged.

## Contraindication

Not for ocular use.
