During his career, Prof. Dr. Florian Beuer has served as Specialist in Implantology for the German Society of Implantology (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Implantologie), as Specialist in Prosthodontics at the German Society of Prosthodontics and Biomaterials (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Prothetische Zahnmedizin und Biomaterialien) as Board Member of the German Academy of Aesthetic Dentistry (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Ästhetische Zahnheilkunde) and as Chairman of the Department of Prosthodontics at Charité University of Medicine, Berlin, Germany. He is executive board member of the German Society of Implantology (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Implantologie) since 2015.
